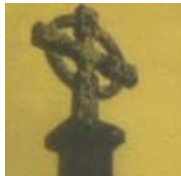

Some things the Deacons do to minister...

BABIES

Welcoming new babies into our church family, giving them and their families a sense of belonging and care.

COMMUNITY RESOURCES

Providing our church family with a written document of resources for assistance in the Bellingham and Whatcom county area, while also educating them regarding the FPC philosophy of helping versus enabling.

COMMUNION AT HOME

For those not able to attend church and take part in communion, our Deacons are available upon request to serve communion in the home.

DEVOTED CARE

Helping to provide care for those in our church family who are shut-in, in crisis, and needing some form of follow-up.

FAMILY CARE

New Deacon Role currently under construction coming out of the Deacons desire to minister to our church families.

FINANCES

Benevolence gifts to those with financial emergencies or in short-term crisis. This is funded entirely by offering donations, so gifting may be limited.

FLOWERS

Delivering or sending flowers to those in the hospital, at the loss of a loved one, or other appropriate events.

HILLTOPPERS

Each time this 55+ lunch group meets, the Deacons are there to serve and visit.

HOSPITAL VISITATION

Visiting church congregation members during overnight stays in the hospital.

MEALS

Helping to provide meals to those in our church family who are in need of assistance because of illness, hospitalization, and other life-altering events.

MEMORIAL SERVICE RECEPTIONS

Hosting receptions for family members and guests following memorial services held at FPC and as requested by FPC.

PRAYER SHAWLS

Knit or crochet Prayer Shawls for those in the hospital, ill at home, or needing some special TLC.

TRANSPORTATION

When possible, facilitating transportation arrangements for the FPC church family who are unable to drive or find alternate transportation to regular or special FPC events. Physical limitations may apply.

*Please **pray** for the Deacons, as well as for the people to whom the Deacons are ministering.*

The first Sunday of each month is usually Deacon's Sunday.

- *In the pew racks, you will find manila envelopes that can be used to donate towards the work of the Deacons.*
- *You can also make donations any time you would like.*
- *If you don't use an envelope, just be sure and note on your check that it is for the Deacons.*
